- Advanced Photoshop tutorials throughout course

Day 1; 16:00-22:00:

Introduction to the creative visual world: Introduction to modern concepts and planning of events/shoots of this intensive creative course.

- 16:00 A look at *Renaissance Art* and the *Wet Plate* (the renaissance of photography).
- 18:00 Short break followed by; Paramount/loop studio lighting portrait shoot.
- 19:00 Dinner
- 20:00 Prepare a clean Photoshop desktop for single screen users.
- Photoshop tutorial 1; the renaissance look. Layers and blends to mix soft and strong focus elements.



Day 2; 6:00-22:00: Full day instruction / Photoshop

- 06:30 Coffee and rusks followed by; early morning photo shoot at grave yard (with smoke) and movement, then, onto autumn trees colour and camera movement.
- 09:00 Breakfast
- 10:00 A look at *Baroque Art* and the *Dramatic Photo*.
- 11:00 Tea followed by; Split and double split studio lighting portrait shoot.
- 12:00 Photoshop short cuts and plugins.
- Photoshop tutorial 2; The dramatic baroque look using layers blends and Nik Collection.
- 13:00 Lunch
- 14:00 A look at *Neo Classic Artists* and *Pictorialist Photographers* Cubism to Abstract philosophy and approach. A look at artists and photographers.
- 14:30 Portrait shoot with *green screen*.
- 15:00 Short break (tea or...) Photoshop EZ Green Screen plugin instruction.
- Photoshop tutorial 3; advanced masking and feather, layers, blends and multi-image.
- Introduction to land art.
- 17:00 Twilight to after dark at cemetery (using paint by light and other lighting effects) with models.
- 19:30 Dinner
- 21:00 A look at *Realism* (the dawn of modern art) and the *Realist* and *travel photographer*.
- A touch of Street Photography with video.
- Brief on early morning exploration shoot for day 3.



Day 3; 6:00-22:00: Full day instruction / Photoshop

- 06:30 Coffee and rusks followed by; travel photography in and around village.
- 09:00 Breakfast
- 10:00 Unpacking Hein's creative guide toolbox. Shooting space, texture, shape, colour and shadow.
- Creative shoot in and around lodge.
- 11:00 Tea followed by; photo show and tell.
- 11:30 A look at *Impressionist* and *Post-Impressionist Artists* and *The Modern Photographer*.
- 12:00 Photoshop tutorial 4; advanced layers, blends, blurs, colour and screens.
- 13:00 Lunch
- 14:00 A look at *Cubism Artists* and *Photographers* philosophy and approach.
- 15:00 Owl House, introducing multi-view photography at Owl House. Again exploiting space, texture, shape, colour and shadow as reference for creative photography.
- 17:30 *Futurism* in art and photography.
- 18:00 *Surrealism* in art and photography.
- 18:30 *Minimalism* in art and photography.
- 19:30 Dinner
- 21:00 Guided night photography in village using mixed light sources, including star trails at church.
- Process star trails.



Day 4; 6:00-22:00: Full day instruction / Photoshop

- 06:30 Coffee and rusks followed by minimalist portraits in village.
- 09:00 Breakfast
- 10:00 Photoshop tutorial 6; layers, opacity and grids for Cubist multi imagery.
- 11:00 Tea followed by; shooting for brushes and textures.
- 12:00 Photoshop tutorial 7; Create and implement screens including raindrops.
- 13:00 Lunch
- 14:00 POP art and Photography.
- 14:30 Shoot and create own brushes.
- 15:00 Short break (tea or...) Photoshop tutorial 8; complex layers, blends and opacities incorporated with own brushes.
- 16:30 Photoshop tutorial 7; THE FULL MONTE all techniques from tutorials to create a post modern futuristic image with a strong blend of refractions.
- 20:00 Christine's famous curry and rice, wine and toasts to conclude our days spend together.
